

2012 Advance Scuba Dive Schedule

Students must bring their PADI card with them

The following days will most likely change depending on weather conditions and diving factors. The team will have autonomy in working together each day to determine what activities the students want to experience and are welcome to make suggestions and additions to activity possibilities.

Sunday, June 24th

Students fly into Fort Lauderdale, Team arrives at Camp Sawyer on West Summerland Key
Set up tents, explore camp, create full value contract, and devise team goals

Monday, June 25th

Acclimate to the keys and get to know teammates. Students choose between following activities- snorkel at local spots, sea kayak, visit dive shop, explore blue hole and local natural environments, fishing, visit beaches, jet skiing, and play games

Tuesday, June 26th

½ day of basic academic dive review in the classroom
½ day of pool diving and reviewing scuba abilities
Evening activity- Cook dinner at parks/beaches, fish, play games, sunset nature walk, etc

Wednesday, June 27th

Full day of open water advance diving instruction at Looe Key National Marine Sanctuary
Evening activity- Cook dinner at parks/beaches, fish, play games, sunset nature walk, etc

Thursday, June 28th

2nd Full day of open water advance diving instruction at Looe Key Marine Sanctuary
Evening activity- Cook dinner at parks/beaches, fish, play games, sunset nature walk, etc

Friday, June 29th

Potential 3rd day of diving (depends on conditions and first days of diving)
Evening activity- Cook dinner at parks/beaches, fish, play games, sunset nature walk, etc

Saturday, June 30th

Activity day- Students choose between the following- boating, tubing, jet skiing, fishing, snorkeling, going to beach/ swimming (Bahia Honda State Park), island exploration, nature walks, local nature center, etc

Sunday, July 1st

Key West day- Students will choose from some of the following- Visit the aquarium or a local shipwreck museum, Mallory square sunset festival, local shopping on Duval street, dinner out at a local restaurant, walk to the southern most point in the US, explore Fort Zachary Taylor, hang out at Key West beaches and look up other potential fun activities

Monday, July 2nd

Activity day- Students choose between the following- boating, tubing, jet skiing, fishing, snorkeling, going to beach/ swimming (Bahia Honda State Park), island exploration, nature walks, local nature center, etc

Tuesday, July 3rd
